



## INITIAL/OVERSEAS STUDENT ADMISSION CHECKLIST

When a student reports to school, the student will:

- Complete a DCCCD Application.
- Provide a copy of Initial Form I-20 and Form I-94 ([www.cbp.gov/I94](http://www.cbp.gov/I94)).
- Provide a copy of the biographical and visa pages of passport.
- Bring proof of having had the meningitis vaccine (21 years old and younger). Please go to [www.dcccd.edu/meningitis](http://www.dcccd.edu/meningitis) for more information about the state of Texas' requirements, deadlines, exceptions and exemptions.
- Be sent to the school's Health Center to receive a TB skin test. There is no charge for this test.

The student will return in 48 hours to:

- Receive the TB Test results.
- Be sent to the Admissions Office to finalize official admission and receive a student ID number.
- Go to the Testing Center to take the appropriate assessment tests.
- Complete the [Online International Student Orientation](#).

After the above process is complete, the student will:

- Register for classes.
- Pay tuition and buy books.
- Go to the Office of Student Life to get a student ID Card.
