Major Preparatory Courses: 3 semester credit hours beyond Core Curriculum

(ECON 2301 and ECON 2303 requirement met if completed at DCCCD prior to transfer to UTD.)
Major Core Courses: 18 semester credit hours
All of the following: ECON 3310, ECON 3311, ECON 4360
Choose two courses from the following: GEOG 3304, IPEC 3349, IPEC 4301, IPEC 4302, PSCI 4329, PSCI 4356, PSCI 4360
(GEOG 2303 equivalent (GEOG 1303) completed at DCCCD prior to transfer to UTD will satisfy 3 SCH.)
International Political Economy: 21 semester credit hours
IPEC Elective from approved courses. (GOVT 2304 completed at DCCCD prior to transfer to UTD will satisfy 3 SCH.)
Area Electives (Major-Related Courses): 9 semester credit hours
Upper-division courses from any given geographic area within IPEC and related fields of study.
Foreign Language Requirement: 12 semester credit hours
(This requirement is met if 12 SCH of the same language is completed at DCCCD prior to transfer to UTD.)
Elective Requirement: 18 semester credit hours
This requirement may be satisfied with lower- and upper-division courses from any field of study.

Please note:

- Students are required to receive a grade of “C” or better for a course to transfer to UT Dallas
- Grades earned in transferred courses will not impact the UT Dallas GPA
- Once you complete the course, you must submit an updated official transcript electronically to the Office of the Registrar.
- No coursework may be taken off campus in a student’s final graduating semester at UT Dallas.
