A total of 51 upper level hours must be completed at UT Dallas. Most courses listed are upper-level (3000/4000) courses that cannot be completed at the community college.

Required courses for Political Science degree:
Major Preparatory Courses (0 semester credit hours beyond Core Curriculum)
One of the following: EPPS 2302 or EPPS 2303 (EPPS 2301 is not a major requirement and is not required if core is completed at DCCCD prior to attending UTD)
Major Core Courses (18 semester credit hours):
All of the following: PSCI 3322, PSCI 3333, PSCI 3362
Two of the following: PSCI 3301, PSCI 3328, PSCI 3350, PSCI 4329
One of the following: PSCI 3325, PSCI 4307, PSCI 4360
Major-Related Courses (39 semester credit hours)
Most students take upper-division PSCI courses. However, subject to UTD advisor approval, courses from other disciplines may be used to satisfy this requirement.

Please note:

- Students are required to receive a grade of "C" or better for a course to transfer to UT Dallas
- Grades earned in transferred courses will not impact the UT Dallas GPA
- Once you complete the course, you must submit an updated official transcript electronically to the Office of the Registrar.
- No coursework may be taken off campus in a student's final graduating semester at UT Dallas.
